

**NEW VISA REGULATIONS FOR INDIAN NATIONALS
ENTERING THE PHILIPPINES**

Effective 05 July 2013, Indian-passport holders may now enter the Philippines visa-free for fourteen (14) days, which can be extended by another seven (7) days for a maximum of twenty-one (21) days provided that he is:

1. In possession of a valid US, Japanese, Australian, Canadian, Schengen, Singaporean, or UK visa, or a permanent residence permit;
2. His national passport is valid for at least six (6) months beyond his intended stay in the Philippines;
3. In possession of a return or onward ticket to the next country of destination; and
4. Without derogatory record with the Philippine Bureau of Immigration (BI), the National Intelligence Coordinating Agency (NICA), and the International Police (Interpol).

The above is implemented at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA) Terminals 1, 2, 3, & 4.

Said admission will be non-convertible to other visa categories.
